



BroncoDesign One- Piece Halfcab- \$865

The BroncoDesign HalfCab is finished on the inside- head and back liner (see pics). The need for expensive reproduction rubber and glass is eliminated by having your local glass shop cut 1/4 inch safety glass gluing the new piece in with modern windshield adhesive (\$50-85 where I live). Upper and rear window frame seals are simple D cell sticky back rubber obtained at any auto parts, RV, or marine store for \$10-15.

Mounting is via a steel strip that runs inside the front gutter and through bolting to your bulkhead in the back. Once you get the top lined up, you mark the hole locations in front using your windshield holes as the guide. Do the same in the back with the bulkhead, take it back off, drill/tap the front holes for 5/16 bolts, and drill through for the back holes.

We make a bulkhead but ours doesn't have the same detail as the steel reproduction one Jeff's sells, which is the same price so I recommend the steel one over ours. The fiberglass bulkhead is for customers who insist on all fiberglass pieces for their build which is becoming more and more common.
